

Helicopter Safety

1. General




Smoking is not permitted in or around this aircraft at anytime or on any Osborne Aviation property.



Luggage must be securely stowed prior to take off. Please ask crew to assist.

2. Entry and Exit

Always approach from the front and exit forwards and only with the pilot's acknowledgement.



Consider the terrain. Approach from the front and exit forwards unless otherwise instructed.



Do not approach the helicopter when starting up and shutting down.

Carry all items flat around the helicopter



Never proceed behind the rear skids due to tail rotor danger.




Key

-  First Aid Kit (Rear compartment)


3. Seat Bets

Adjustments can be made by pulling on the strap to tighten.

Lap type (back seats)




Harness type (front seat)



4. Doors

Front Door



2 Push door out

1 Lift handle upwards

Rear doors



Slide door

1 Lift handle upwards

! Evacuation would occur through the door closest to you.

5. Life jackets

For a landing on water follow all directions given by crew. Only inflate the life jacket once you are outside the aircraft.



Operation to inflate is the same for vest type jackets.



1. Pull orange tab upwards so the life jacket comes out of the bag.

Whistle



2. Put head through the large hole.

Mouthpiece for further inflation



3. To inflate, pull down on red tags. There is a mouth piece for further inflation.

6. Remember

! Be sure to follow the instructions of crew and signage at all times. .

! If ever unsure about something, ask. If you can't ask, it's safest to stop where you are and wait for assistance.
